RECALL OF "HERMANN" TO MOSCOW (1945)

From: MOSCOW

To: THE HAGUE

31 December 1945

[i] We have decided to recall " $\underline{\text{HERMANN[GERMAN]"}}$  to MOSCOW. When he visits the Legation[MISSIYa][a] say that in accordance with his letter he is being summoned to MOSCOW to report. Arrange his departure in accordance with your suggestion through the Soviet Repatriation Commission. Wire the date of departure. Do not disclose yourself as "HERMANN".
