The person who sent this to you is applying for a Title VIII Short-Term Research Scholarship at the Kennan Institute of the Wilson Center to undertake the attached project proposal. The applicant has identified you as one of two individuals who are familiar with the applicant's work and qualifications and who would be asked to comment specifically on the proposed study and the applicant's ability to undertake it.

We would appreciate receiving from you a full and candid evaluation both of the candidate and of the proposed study project. The basic criteria for selection of scholars are:

- 1) the importance and originality of the project (the quality of the project proposal and the degree to which the key questions have been identified and a promising approach outlined);
- 2) the applicant's scholarly capabilities, achievement, and the ability to accomplish the proposed project; and
- 3) the likelihood that the work, when completed, will advance basic understanding of the topic under study and represent a substantial contribution to the body of knowledge about it.

You should also be aware that the Kennan Institute and the Wilson Center strive to encourage active scholarly dialogue and exchange of views and perspectives among fellows and between them and the public at large. While working on their projects, fellows are also members of an intellectual community who are encouraged to participate in the institutional life of the Wilson Center in both formal and informal ways, ranging from informal conversations to involvement in the Center's meetings, colloquia, and conferences. It is with this background in mind that we ask for your opinion as to whether the applicant would contribute to the community life of the Institute and the
